



Discovery of the Témiscouata Area and Lake Témiscouata

This tour of the Témiscouata area will take you through typical Bas-Saint-Laurent scenery, from coastal farmland to vast forest plateaus and alongside magnificent lakes and rivers.

The tour includes visits to Parc national du Lac-Témiscouata; Domaine Vallier Robert, a maple economuseum specializing in maple alcoholic beverages; and Fort Ingall, a faithful reconstruction of a British fort built in 1839 on the banks of Lake Témiscouata.

Sunday, October 26, 2025

8:15 a.m. Drive from Rivière-du-Loup to Témiscouata-sur-le-Lac (45 min – 62 km)

9 a.m. Visit of Fort Ingall

A faithful reconstruction of a British fortress built in 1839 during a border conflict between Canada and the United States, Fort Ingall is made up of eight buildings surrounded by a wooden palisade. The permanent exhibition presents the life of the soldiers as well as the geopolitical context of this period.

9:45 a.m. Drive from Témiscouata-sur-le-Lac to Saint-Michel-du-Squatec (45 min – 68 km)

10:30 a.m. Visit of Parc national du Lac-Témiscouata and short hike

This national park is a unique blend of breathtaking lakes and rivers, vast and lush forests and nearly 10,000 years of history. A wide variety of hiking trails are available to visitors of all ages, as are a multitude of activities ranging from biking to canoeing, kayaking, SUP, etc. (with equipment available for rent in the park). Visitors can also participate in actual archaeological digs. Be on the lookout as the park is a good place to see white-tailed deer and bald eagles!

Hike in the Garden of Memories and visit of the park's "ready-to-camp" glamping units

12 p.m. Lunch at the Grand-Lac-Touladi Visitors Centre

12:45 p.m. Drive from the Grand-Lac-Touladi sector to Auclair (15 min)

1 p.m. Visit of **Domaine Vallier Robert** and tasting session

Domaine Vallier Robert is a maple economuseum that specializes in making fine maple products, including four alcoholic beverages: Val Ambré (a fortified wine similar to Pineau des Charentes), Charles-Aimé Robert (a tawny port-style dessert wine), Prémices d'Avril (a wine resembling a semi-dry white) and Mousse des Bois (a dry sparkling wine). Learn about how maple sap is harvested, tour the ageing cellars, visit the boutique and enjoy tasting their products!

2 p.m. Drive from Auclair to Témiscouata-sur-le-Lac with stop at the Cabano marina (45 min – 51 km)

2:45 p.m. Visit of Auberge du Chemin Faisant

A historic house combining the luxurious beauty of the 1950s with refined comfort and modern amenities, Auberge du Chemin Faisant offers you a warm welcome in the heart of the Témiscouata area. The inn's six rooms are very charming and provide a dream getaway in a stylish and romantic decor.

3:15 p.m. Drive from Témiscouata-sur-le-Lac to Rivière-du-Loup (45 min – 61 km)

4 p.m. Arrival at your hotel
